Payments to City Hall

The forms of payments to the City of Vinita Park must be cash, money orders, credit/debit card, or a business check. No personal checks will be accepted for payment. We apologize FEMA and Citizen Corps to help you for any inconvenience.

Code Adoption

Ordinance No. 1247, Adoption of the National Electrical Code/2008, NFPA 70 and Ordinance No. 1248, Adoption of the International Code Council (ICC) Codes were passed at the March 16, 2015 Board Meeting. The following code books will be on file at the City Hall for public to view 2009 ICC Code Book and 2008 National Electrical Code Book (NEC).

BASIC EMERGENCY SUPPLY KIT

A basic emergency supply kit could include the following recommended items:

- · Water, one gallon of water per person per day for at least three days, for drinking and sanitation
- · Food, at least a three-day supply of non-perishable food
- Battery-powered or hand crank radio and a NOAA Weather Radio with tone alert and extra batteries for both
- Flashlight and extra batteries
- First aid kit
- Whistle to signal for help
- · Dust mask to help filter contaminated air and plastic sheeting and duct tape to shelter-in-place
- · Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation
- Wrench or pliers to turn off utilities
- · Manual can opener for food
- Local maps
- Cell phone with chargers, inverter or solar charger

Once you have gathered the supplies for a basic emergency kit, you may want to consider adding the following items:

- Prescription medications and glasses
- Infant formula and diapers
- Pet food and extra water for your pet
- Cash or traveler's checks and change
- Important family documents such as copies of insurance policies.

identification and bank account records in a waterproof, portable container. You can use the Emergency Financial First Aid Kit - EFFAK (PDF -977Kb) developed by Operation Hope. organize your information.

- Emergency reference material such as a first aid book or free information from this web site. (See Publications)
- Sleeping bag or warm blanket for each person. Consider additional bedding if you live in a cold-weather
- · Complete change of clothing including a long sleeved shirt, long pants and sturdy shoes. Consider additional clothing if you live in a cold-weather climate.
- Household chlorine bleach and medicine dropper – When diluted, nine parts water to one part bleach, bleach can be used as a disinfectant. Alternatively, in an emergency, you can use it to treat water by using 16 drops of regular household liquid bleach per gallon of water. Do not use scented, color safe or bleaches with added cleaners.
- Fire extinguisher
- · Matches in a waterproof container
- Feminine supplies and personal hygiene items
- Mess kits, paper cups, plates, paper towels and plastic utensils
- Paper and pencil
- · Books, games, puzzles or other activities for children

WORDS FROM THE MAYOR

We need to continue to work together on improving our city. Our City Administration, Police Department, Public Works Department, and Board of Aldermen are working hard to keep our city running more effective and efficient.

I would like to say congratulations to Robert Edward Davis for receiving an Achievement Award on being accepted to Washington University. I also want to congratulate Jeff Carvel the Public

Works Foreman on receiving an award for his dedicated service to the City of Vinita Park along with his wife Nikki Carvel and their daughter Kayla Carvel whom both received awards for their continuous and outstanding volunteer work.

The city park behind Vinita Park City Hall will be closed during the months of May through June for park renovation. There will be a new pavilion, new bathroom, two new benches around the play area, and also two new barbeque grills. St. Louis County Department of Transportation removed the decorative quard rails from all the dead end streets at Midland Blvd within Vinita Park and Vinita Terrace, and replaced them with metal poles. These poles do not create the same safety purpose nor are they decorative. We can let our voices be heard at the next Department of Transportation Board Meeting on Monday March 13, 2017 at 3:00p.m. 1050 North Lindbergh Blvd Creve Coeur, MO 63132, Missouri Sewer District (MSD) will be replacing our storm-water pipe underneath the bike/walk trail. Please be mindful of this construction work and to all safety signs.

Once this pipe is replaced the bike/walk trail will be restored to full use.

I would like to say congratulations to all of the residents who graduated from the Citizen Police Academy. I would like to thank all of the police officers who taught the Police Academy Class during their free time. They did a great job and it was a huge success. I would advise all of the residents to be a part of the Citizen Police Academy to see what it's like to be a police officer.

Our police officers work hard to keep our city safe. Within the first 3 months of operation with our Special Operation Division the North County Cooperative Police Department has made 42 arrests with 74 felony charges all of which are drug and gun related, did 13 search warrants, 37 firearms were seized, and 2 drive-bys were prevented. A large quantity of Marijuana, Heroin, PCP, and Cocaine has been seized. Our police officers are doing a great job with getting drugs and guns off our streets and keeping our city safe. I want to thank them again for all of their hard work.

PUBLIC WORKS NEWS

Permits

Please come to City Hall to secure the proper permits PRIOR to having any work done to your property. Doing so will prevent unnecessary delays and fines. If you are not sure if you need a permit PLEASE call City Hall at 314-428-7373 to inquire.

Occupancy Inspection and Permit Required

It shall be unlawful for any person or family to occupy or for any owner or agent to permit the occupant of any building or dwelling of a unit, until the inspection is complete and an occupancy permit has been issued. The occupancy permit shall not be issued until all violations on the property have been brought into compliance.

Mosquitos

As we approach the mosquito season it is very important to remove all items from your property that may hold water. Failure to do so can result in a summons to appear in court and possible fine. Some items to look for are: tires, swimming pools, pottery, and etc.

Yard Waste

All Yard Waste should be placed in a designated yard waste can or brown yard bags for pickup. Yard Waste in plastic bags will NOT be picked up.

New Ordinances

The Vinita Park Board of Aldermen recently passed several new ordinances that may apply to you. Provided below is a synopsis of each Ordinance.

Ordinance 1286 (Occupancy Permits) – changes Section 510.120(B) of the Code of Ordinances relating to Occupancy Permits. The Ordinance adds a provision that prior to obtaining an Occupancy Permit all applicable service charges, fees, trash

bills and real estate taxes have been paid in full. There were no other changes to the Ordinance and all other previous requirements for obtaining an Occupancy Permit still apply. City Hall staff will be verifying that the above referenced charges and fees are paid in full prior to issuing occupancy permits

Ordinance 1288 (Trash Dumpster Enclosures) — requires trash dumpster enclosures to be constructed at commercial, and multi-family dwelling locations in the City of Vinita Park. This ordinance is immediately effective for all newly placed dumpsters in the City of Vinita Park. If a building has an existing dumpster, an enclosure must be built around the dumpster, following the specifications listed in the Ordinance, by November 1, 2016. Please be advised that a Building Permit must be obtained prior to starting construction of the enclosure.

Ordinance 1289 (Rental Registration Licenses) —requires that any owner of a single-family residential rental property must annually register each property they own and obtain a Rental License from the City of Vinita Park. It also requires that prior to any rental license being issued all applicable service charges, fees, trash bills and real estate taxes are paid in full.

Reminder

As we strive to keep our city Clean & Beautiful please do not place trash/yard waste/recycle receptacles on the curb before dusk of the evening before pickup. Once the trash/yard waste/recycle

receptacles have been emptied they should be removed from the curb the same

day it was picked up. Failure to comply with the above could result in the resident receiving a summons to appear in court.
